I'm contacting you about our bike club, Berkshire Velo, who are planning to host a recreational bike ride that starts in West Stockbridge on Saturday, April 22rd. Similar to the previous couple of years (Berkshire Backroad Gravel Grinder - B2G2), we're hoping to use the open space adjacent to the Water & Sewer building on Moscow Road.

The ride is self-guided (via GPS) and features many of the scenic gravel and backroads of West Stockbridge. Registration for the roughly 100 anticipated riders will take place between 10AM and noon. Riders start at their leisure and we anticipate most finishing no later than 3 PM.

We'd like to stress that this is NOT a mass start event that attracts a crowd outside of the participants. We'll remind riders to obey local traffic regulations including riding single file through the town. We're happy to promote local businesses for post ride meals, refreshments, etc.

As riders come from all over New England and NYC/Boston, we believe B2G2 helps promote the beauty and charm of West Stockbridge and the surrounding area. We received permission the last two years and are hoping to get permission again this year.

To the Board of Selectmen Of West Stockbridge, Massachusetts

Massachusetts Electric Company d/b/a NATIONAL GRID requests permission to locate poles, wires, and fixtures, including the necessary sustaining and protecting fixtures, along and across the following public way:

Baker Street - Install 10 SO Poles on Baker Street. Beginning at a point approximately 3263 feet Northerly of the centerline of the intersection of Baker Street and State Line Road and continuing approximately 1283 feet in a Northerly direction. Extending pole line up North on Baker St. to serve Wiseacre Farm.

Location approximately as shown on plan attached.

Wherefore it prays that after due notice and hearing as provided by law, it be granted a location for and permission to erect and maintain poles and wires, together with such sustaining and protecting fixtures as it may find necessary, said poles to be erected substantially in accordance with the plan filed herewith marked – Baker Street - West Stockbridge, Massachusetts.

Also, for permission to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables, and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as each of said petitioners may desire for distributing purposes.

Your petitioner agrees to reserve space for one cross-arm at a suitable point on each of said poles for the fire, police, telephone, and telegraph signal wires belonging to the municipality and used by it exclusively for municipal purposes.
